

PRIVACY NOTICE – Blue Badge Scheme

Who is the Data Controller for the information I provide?

Halton Borough Council is the Data Controller for the personal information you provide.

We collect and hold information about you in order to progress your Blue Badge application form.

Why do you need my information?

We need your data in order to progress your application.

What legal basis allows you to use my information?

Under the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act, Halton Borough Council has a statutory obligation to maintain a register showing the holders of badges issued by the authority. It is responsible for determining and implementing administrative,

assessment and enforcement procedures in accordance with the governing legislation Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended.

Do I have to provide this information and what will happen if I don't?

If you do not provide this information we cannot progress your application?

Who will my information be shared with?

Your information may be shared with other departments within Halton Borough Council. The Blue Badge print solution supplier, as part of a contract for the production of the blue badge. Other local Authority Blue Badge enforcement teams. Police for parking enforcement. If you move address to another local authority, your Blue Badge Registration record may be transferred if requested by the new Local Authority.

How long will you keep this information for and why?

Documents and emails will be kept for seven years.

How will my information be stored?

Your data will be stored electronically in our customer relation database on a secure network.

Will this information be used to take automated decisions about me?

What rights do I have when it come to my data?

Right to be informed - through this Privacy Notice

Right to rectification – you have the right to have personal data rectified if it is inaccurate or incomplete.

Right to erasure – you have the right to have personal data erased and to prevent processing however the right to erasure does not apply in some circumstances.

Right of Access - you have the right under the Data Protection Act 1998 (General Data Protection Regulation 2018) to request a copy of your information and to know what it is used for and how it has been shared. This is called the right of subject access.
