Why do you need my information?

The information we have asked you to provide on this application is in line with the requirements of the Care Act regulations and guidelines which govern the Deferred Payment Scheme. The information you have provided is required in order for us to determine if you meet the criteria for the council to agree to a deferral of your residential care fees. The information you provide may also be used to internal statistical purposes to improve or inform future policy decisions.

What legal basis allows you to use my information?

Processing is necessary for **compliance with a legal obligation** to which Halton Borough Council, as data controller, is subject.

Who will my information be shared with?

In some cases we may share your information with other council departments and external government agencies such as Department of Works and Pensions, Pension Service, Audit and the police. Sharing of any information will only ever be in relation to the detection or prevention of fraud and error, financial abuse and recovery of debts owed to the Council, or to ensure maximisation of your benefit entitlement

How long will you keep this information for and why?

Information you provide to us on this application will be retained for 7 years in line with the Council's Retention Policy.

How will my information be stored?

Your personal information will be stored electronically on Halton Borough Council's secured network.

What rights do I have when it comes to my data?

- Right to be informed – through this Privacy Notice
- Right to rectification – you have the right to have personal data rectified if it is inaccurate or incomplete.
