

EARLY INTERVENTION

How are we using your information?

If your family is assessed as eligible to receive support from Public Services, such as the Council, the Police and NHS, we may share your personal information between local services and the Government for research processes. It may be sent to the Government on a regular basis.

Why is my information being shared?

The information will be used to produce a National Impact Study which will help make services better in the future. Sharing your information helps the Government and local Public Services understand whether or not the support families receive has been effective in supporting people in Halton. Sharing information helps us to work with you more effectively to benefit your family. It will be collected by the Council and other Public Services on a regular basis to measure progress in providing better services.

How will it affect me?

It will not affect your benefits, services or treatments you are currently entitled to. Your information will be shared and kept securely in line with the law.
