



Care Act – What is a Care and Support Review?



Your review is a meeting to talk about how things are working with your care and support plan. Your review will check to see if anything needs to change.



You have the right to be involved in care and support review and to be given information in a way that is easy to understand.



Everyone who is involved in your care will be asked how things are going with your plan.

Your social worker will want to know:



- What is going well with your care and support?



- What isn't going well with your care and support?



- Have your care and support needs changed?
- Has anything else changed in your life?



- Are you getting the support to do the things that are important to you?



- Would you like to be in more control of your own services using a direct payment?



- Is there anything you are worried about?



- Are you happy with your care and support plan?
