SECTION 30 CHESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ACT 1980

STANDARD CONDITIONS

1. Trading shall only be carried out by the Consent Holder in accordance with the Consent Conditions.
2. The original Form of Consent must be carried by the Consent Holder and produced on demand to any authorised Council Officer or Police Officer.
3. The Consent Holder shall while trading wear the identity badge provided by the Council.
4. The trader must be insured against third party liability. Details of the cover must be displayed on any van, motor vehicle, portable stall etc., used in connection with street trader in such a way that it can be easily read by members of the public.
5. **No trading** must take place outside the hours of 9.30am to 7.00pm.
6. The Consent Holder must not stay in any one street for more than 30 minutes and must not return to that street within a period of 2 hours.
7. The Consent Holder must not trade within 50 metres of another Consent Holder.
8. Any van, vehicle, portable stall etc., used in connection with the sale of food must be registered with the appropriate authority.
9. If the trade is likely to cause odours the trader must obtain and act upon the advice of the Council's **Operational Director - Environmental Health and Consumer Protection**.
10. The trader must ensure that the carrying out of trade does not cause litter and must provide adequate litter receptacles and remove any litter caused by way of trade.
11. Any van, motor vehicles, portable stall etc., used in connection with street trade must be taxed, insured and comply with all relevant highway regulations.
12. The carrying out of street trade must be in accordance with relevant Traffic Regulation Orders.
13. The carrying out of street trade must not cause emergency access and exits to become obstructed nor must it cause any obstruction to the free flow of traffic.

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14. The carrying out of street trade must not cause any obstruction to pedestrian right of way nor must it obstruct access to or egress from private driveways.
15. The carrying out of street trade must not cause any nuisance affecting residents peaceful enjoyment of their homes and traders must comply at all times with all Codes of Practice relating to noise.
16. The trader must make adequate provision for the overnight parking of any van, motor vehicle, portable stall etc., used in connection with a street trade and such arrangements must not cause a nuisance to neighbours, or contravene any relevant planning or highway regulations.
17. The trader must allow, at all reasonable times, entry by any authorised Council Officer or Police Officer to any trade vehicle or trade receptacle for the purpose of inspection.
18. Failure to comply with the conditions of a Consent may lead to the Consent being revoked.
