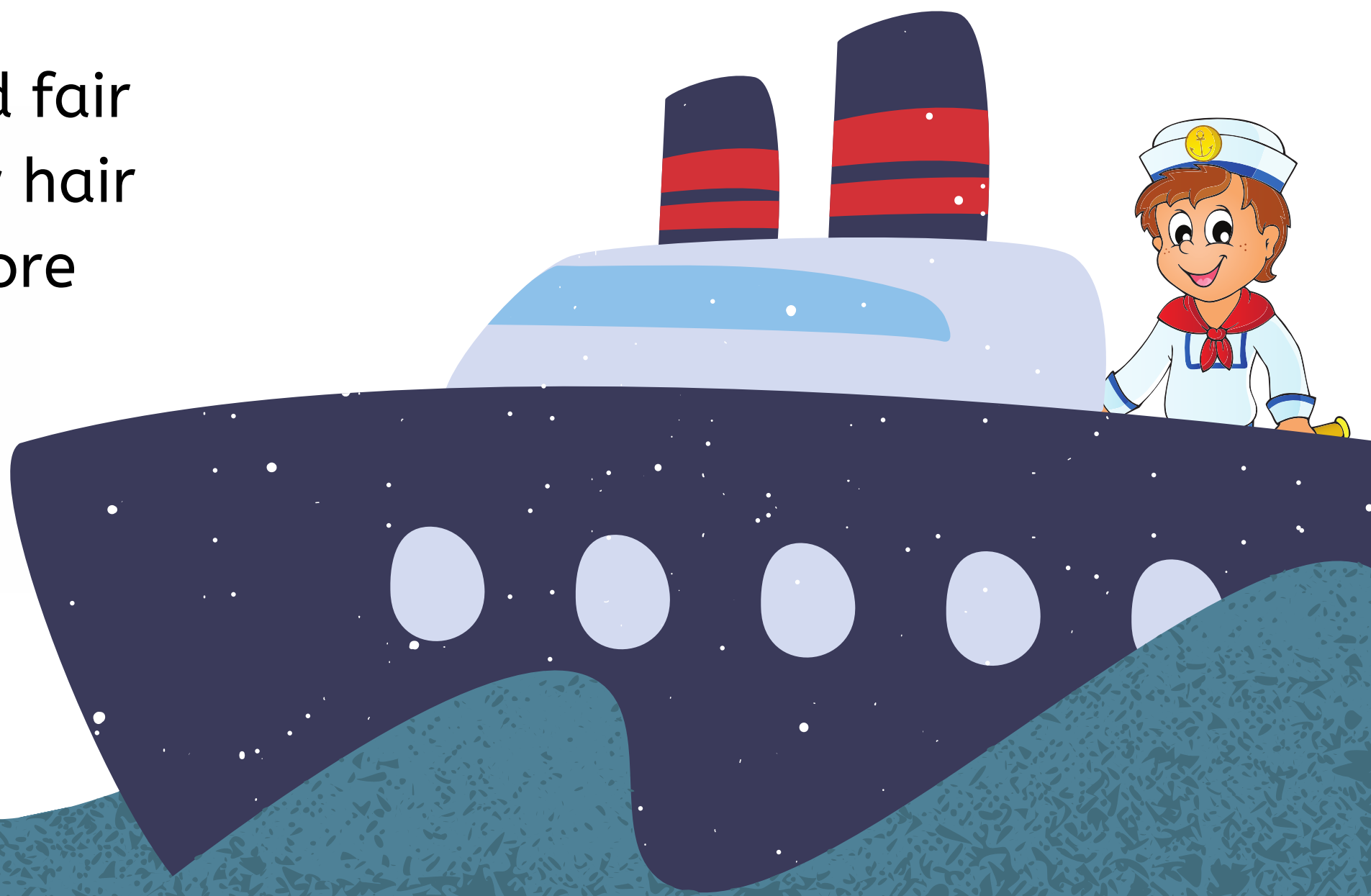

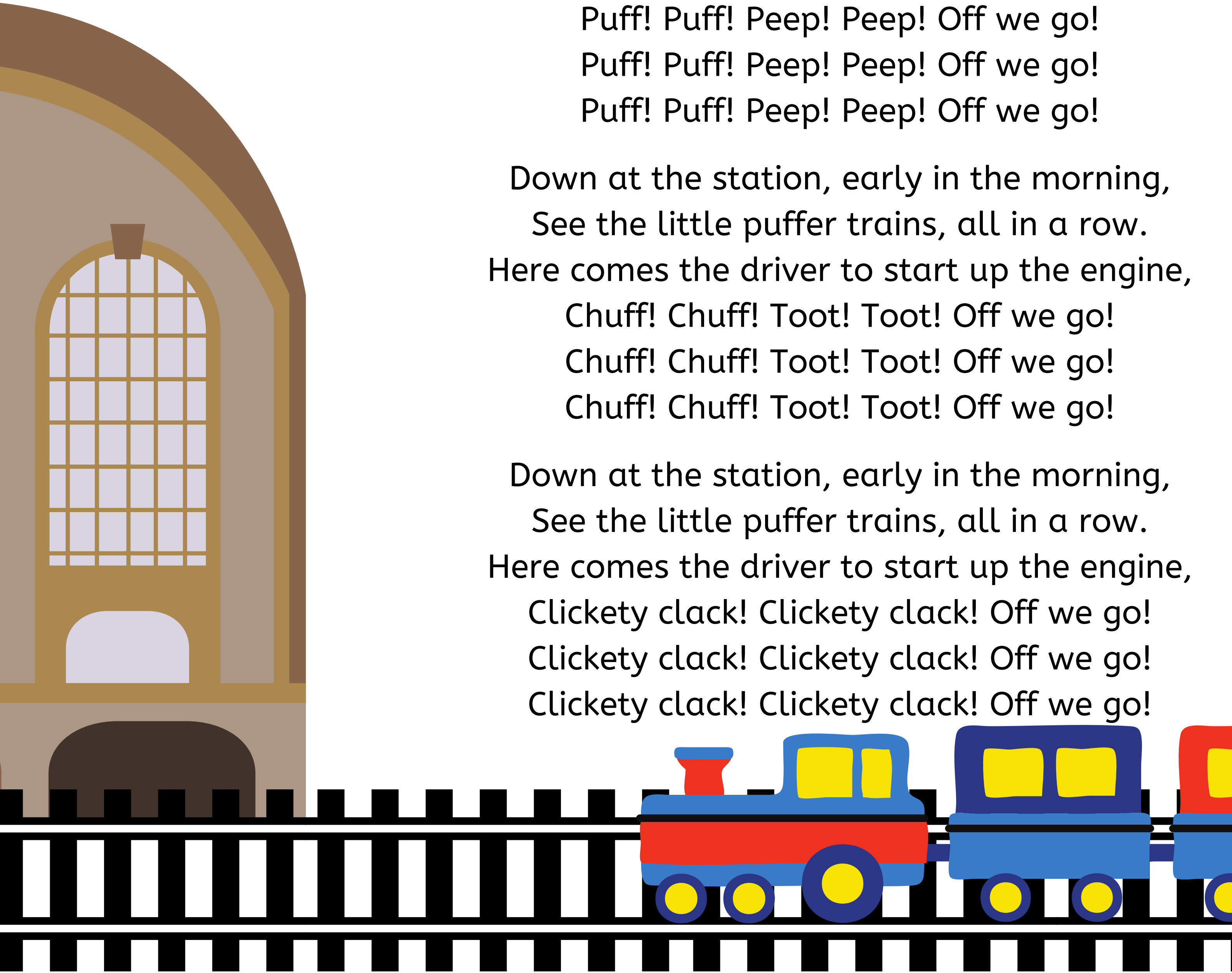

Pat a Cake

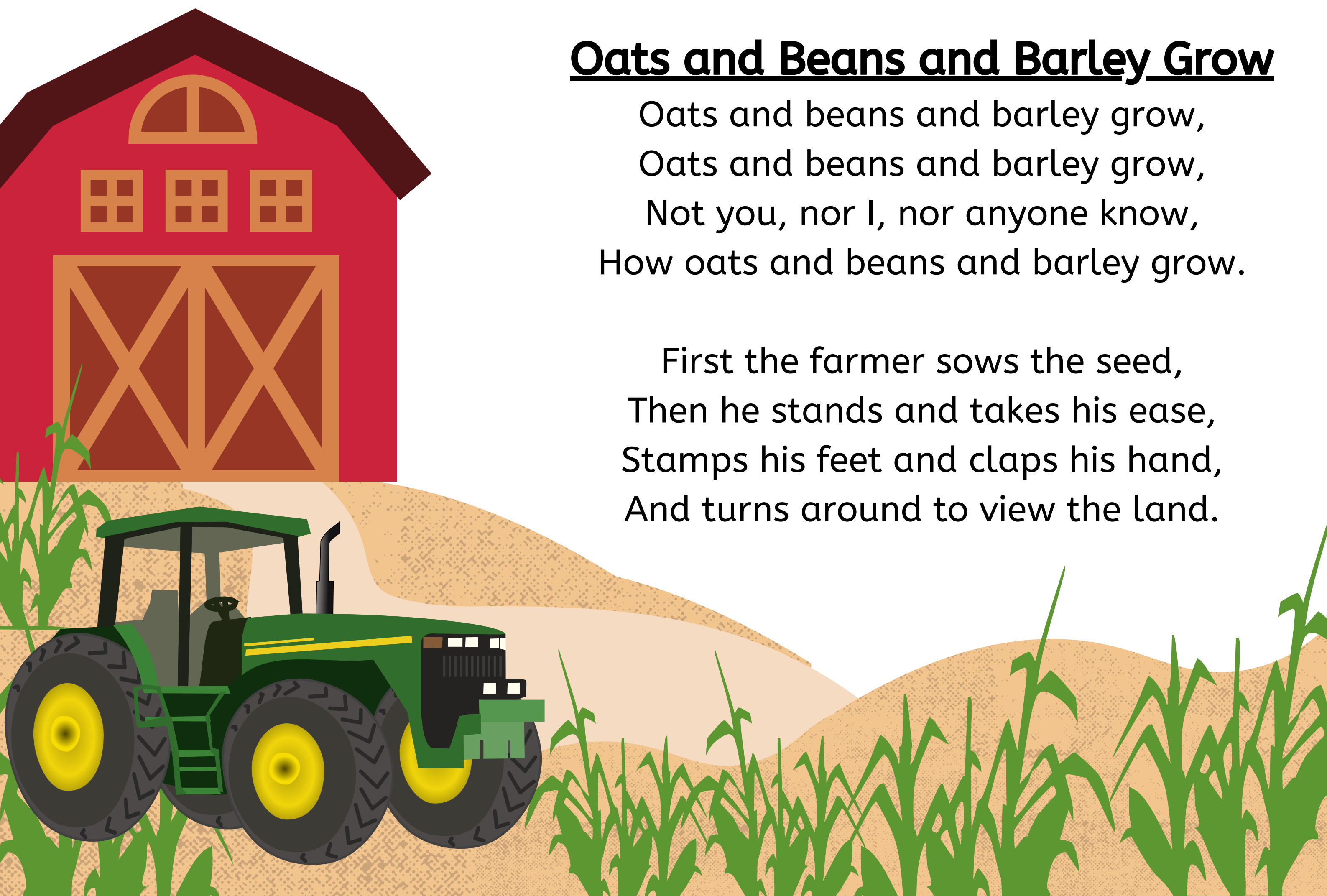
Pat a cake pat a cake baker's man
