**Do Not Knock
Leave and Don't Return**

Failure to do so is a criminal offence

(The Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading Regulations 2008)

DON'T DEAL WITH UNINVITED CALLERS

DON'T agree to buy on the doorstep

DON'T let a stranger into your home

DON'T feel that you're being rude by keeping the door closed or sending them away

DON'T be scared to say '**No Thank You**' and close the door

DO keep the door chain on

DO point to the sign to make sure the caller has seen it

DO ask for ID if they say they are officials (e.g. council workers, utility companies or the Police). Phone the organisation on the number in the Phone Book to check who they are.

DO make a note of any registration numbers or company names

DO report any sellers who ignore this notice to the Citizens Advice Consumer Helpline on 03454 04 05 06
