Dear Neighbour

Important Safety Information for Local Residents and Businesses to Read and Retain.

The activities on site have not changed but some of the chemicals that we work with at ICoNiChem are included under the Control of Major Accident Hazards (COMAH) regulations.

Under these regulations ICoNiChem Widnes Ltd is required to issue information about safety to people who live and work within a set distance of their site. This is referred to as the Public Information Zone (PIZ). The PIZ for ICoNiChem Widnes Ltd has been set by the Health and Safety Executive at the site boundary we have opted to inform our neighbours to ensure their safety in the unlikely event of a major incident.

ICoNiChem Widnes Ltd continues to working in partnership with Risk and Emergency Planning at Halton Borough Council, emergency services and the Environment Agency to develop safety information. Please find enclosed; an updated copy of the Safety Information leaflet about the site and operations and an Emergency Advice card which explains what you should do in an emergency.

These documents are important and have been produced for your safety.

Please read the documents carefully and keep the Emergency Advice card in a safe place where you can quickly and easily refer to it if needed.

If you vacate the property please leave this information for the new occupant.

Please make sure that you and others in your household or business are familiar with the instructions and are aware of the emergency alarm, the regular testing and what actions you would all need to take in an emergency.
