

STREET TRADING CONSENTS

LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS ACT 1982

STANDARD CONDITIONS

1. Trade shall only be carried out within the areas specified in the Form of Consent.
2. The original Form of Consent must be displayed on any van, motor vehicle, portable stall etc., used in connection with street trading, in such a way that it can be easily read by members of the public.
3. The trader must be insured against third party liability. Details of the cover must be displayed on any van, motor vehicle, portable stall etc., used in connection with street trader in such a way that it can be easily read by members of the public.
4. No trade must take place outside the hours of 9.30am to 7.00pm.
5. The trader must not stay in any one street for more than 30 minutes and must not return to that street within a period of 2 hours.
6. The trader must not trade within 50 metres of another street trader.
7. The place where any van, vehicle, portable stall etc., used in connection with the sale of food is ordinarily kept must be registered with the appropriate authority.
8. If the trade is likely to cause odours the trader must obtain and act upon the advice of the Council's Director of Environmental Services.
9. The trader must ensure that the carrying out of trade does not cause litter and must provide adequate litter receptacles and remove any litter caused by way of trade.
10. Any van, motor vehicles, portable stall etc., used in connection with street trade must be taxed, insured and comply with all relevant highway regulations.
11. The carrying out of street trade must be in accordance with relevant Traffic Regulation Orders.
12. The carrying out of street trade must not cause emergency access and exits to become obstructed nor must it cause any obstruction to the free flow of traffic.

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13. The carrying out of street trade must not cause any obstruction to pedestrian right of way nor must it obstruct access to or egress from private driveways.
14. The carrying out of street trade must not cause any nuisance affecting residents peaceful enjoyment of their homes and traders must comply at all times with all Codes of Practice relating to noise.
15. The trader must make adequate provision for the overnight parking of any van, motor vehicle, portable stall etc., used in connection with a street trade and such arrangements must not cause a nuisance to neighbours, or contravene any relevant planning or highway regulations.
16. The trader must not allow tables and/or chairs to be placed in any street in connection with street trade.
17. The trader must not place or permit others to place any advertisement on any street in connection with street trade other than any advertisement painted on any van, motor vehicle, or portable stall authorised by this consent.
18. The trader must allow, at all reasonable times, entry by any authorised Council Officer or Police Officer to any trade vehicle or trade receptacle for the purpose of inspection.
19. Failure to comply with the conditions of a Street Trading Consent may lead to the Consent being revoked.
