Talk to me about getting dressed

Getting dressed/undressed provides a great opportunity to develop your child's speech, language and communication skills.



 Encourage your child to help you find the items of clothing that you need (e.g. long stripey socks, blue fluffy jumper)

 Talk through each stage of getting dressed. Name the items and the part of the body (e.g. socks on your feet)

 Talk to your child about the different clothes items (e.g. What do they feel like? What are they made of?)

 Make up songs together about getting dressed (e.g. This is the way we put on our socks, put on our socks, put on our socks, this is the way we put on our socks, to get ready in the morning).

Shake it all about!
You do the Hokey
Cokey
And you turn around

about!
