Talk about what's outside

Talking to your child about what they can see from the window is a lovely way to develop their speech, language and communication skills.



Talk about and describe what you can see from the window - you could turn this into a game of 'I Spy'.

Talk about the weather. What is it like outside today? What clothes should you wear ready to go outside? Why?
