 Before you go to the shops encourage your child to help you to create a shopping list.

 Talk about what you can see, hear and smell in the shop as you go round and compare similar items (e.g. big bottle of juice).

 Ask your child to help find items (e.g. a big apple) and place them in the trolley (e.g. put the apple next to the bananas).

 Talk about the different departments/sections in the shop (e.g. bakery, groceries, frozen). Talk about what you would find where and why.
