Talk to me in the car

Going on a journey with your child is a great opportunity to develop their speech, language and communication skills.



Talk to you child about where you are going and what you will see. Point things out along the way and describe what you see (e.g look at the big, hairy dog).



Play 'I Spy' together. Describe something that can be seen and encourage your child to guess what it is.



Listening is important too. Listen to the different sounds that the vehicles passing by make (e.g. does a motorbike sound the same as a truck). Once your child is familiar with the different sounds try guessing what vehicle it might be before it passes by.



Make up simple songs together about driving in the car (e.g. The wheels on the car go round and round, round and round.....)
